



Drawing an object begins with some basic shapes. Look around and you'll see them in everything.




## Let's Draw an Owl!

Start your drawing with very light pencil lines and darken them later.


Step 1: Make a large oval for the body. Draw a circle for the head. Inside the head, make two smaller ovals that touch for the feathers around the eyes



Step 2: Add triangles for the ears. Use triangles for the beak and the feathers that look like ears. Put ovals below the body for tail feathers. Draw two half circles or either side of the body for wings.



Step 3: Add a rectangle for the perch and put groups of three small ovals for the toes. Add half circles across the chest to represent feathers.



Now you have your drawing. Darken the lines you want to keep and gently erase any you don't want. Your owl is ready to be colored.
