

Drawing an object begins with some basic shapes. Look around and you'll see them in everything.



Squares, Rectangles & Cubes



Circles, Ovals, & Spheres



Triangles, Cones & Pyramids



Curves & lines to connect the shapes




Use the shapes to draw anything, like this house.

Let's Draw a Sailboat!

Start your drawing with very light pencil lines and darken them later.
Use the light blue lines in the examples as a guide.

Step 1 Draw two curved lines, or an oval, toward the bottom of the page. Add a long, thin cone coming up from the oval at an angle.



Step 2
Draw a triangle on the right side of the cone. Draw a half circle with a curved bottom on the left side. Add curved lines across the oval for waves of water.



Step 3
Add curved lines across the half circle. Add a rectangle with circles for the cabin. Add a flag with two jagged lines at the top of the cone.



Now you have your drawing. Darken the lines you want to keep and gently erase any you don't want. Your sailboat is ready to be colored.
