


Natural Compasses



Find a rock with moss growing on the surface. More moss will grow on the north face of the rock.






- 1. Locate the Big Dipper constellation in the night sky.
- 2. Find the pointer stars on the Big Dipper. They are the two lowest stars on the constellation.
- 3. Follow the line to the North Star.
- 4. Draw an imaginary line straight down from the North Star to the ground.



1. Find an open area with sunlight and put a stick in the ground and mark the tip of the shadow.



- 2. Wait 10-15 minutes.
- 3. Mark the new position of the shadow's tip.

- 4. Draw a straight line between the two marks. This is the east-west line.
- s. Stand with the first mark (west) on your left and the other (east) on your right. You are now facing toward true north.
