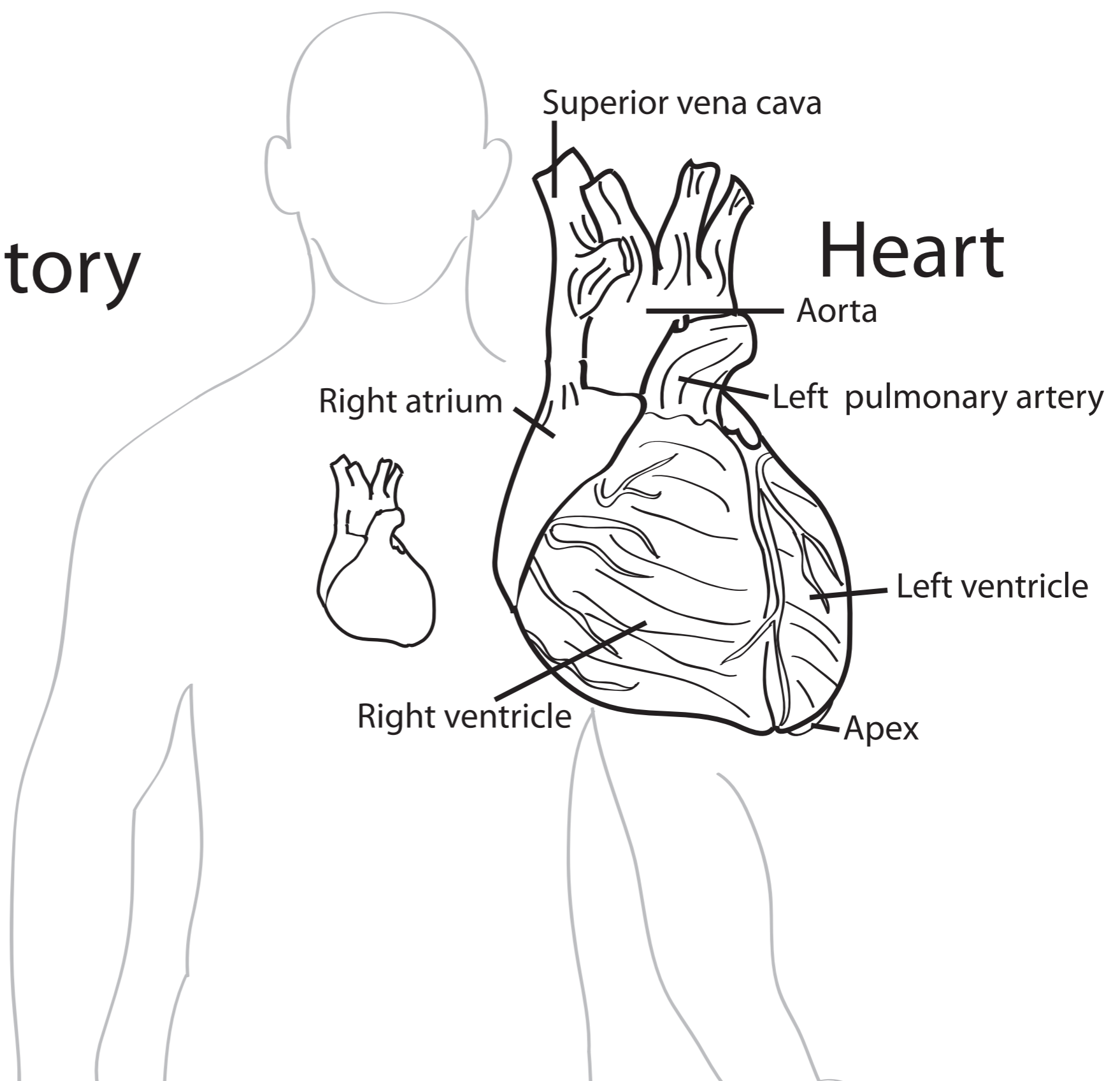


The Circulatory System
