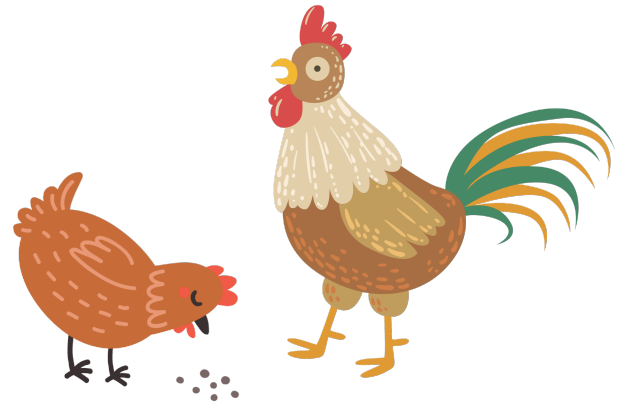


## Identifying Adjectives in Sentences: Honey Hill Farm
