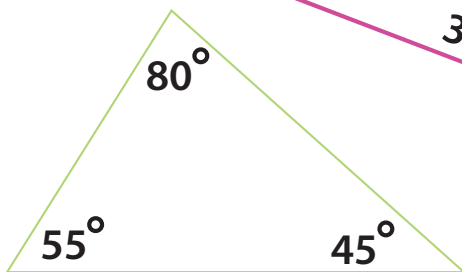
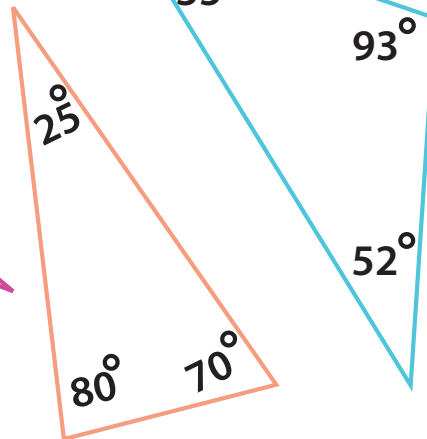
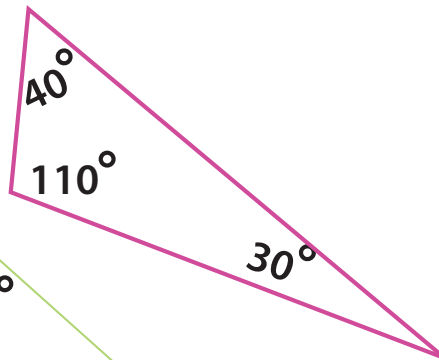
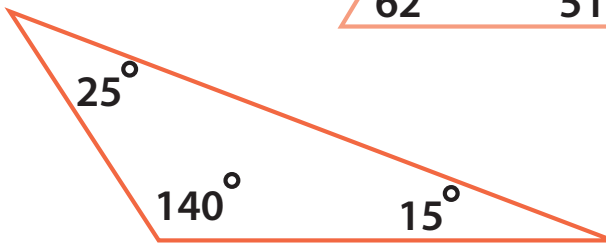
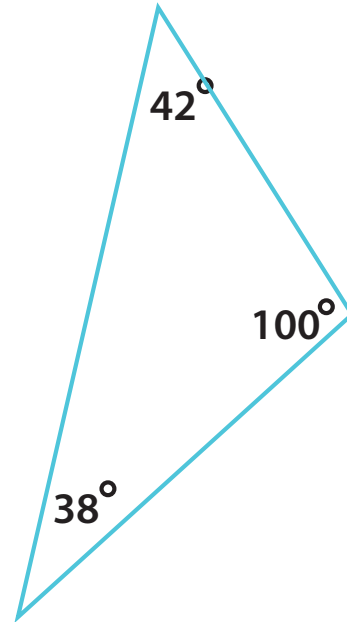
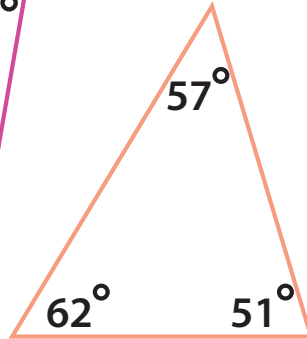
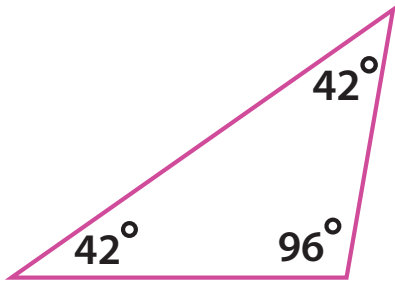


Identifying Triangles: Obtuse Triangles
