

Male Urogenital System:

organs of the urinary system and reproductive system

1. **kidneys**- pair of organs in the abdominal cavity which remove waste from the blood and excrete it as urine
2. **ureters**- pair of ducts which transport urine from the kidneys to the bladder
3. **bladder**- muscular sac in which urine is collected for excretion
4. **urethra**- duct through which urine and sperm are conveyed out of the body
5. **penis**- male genital organ which eliminates urine from the body and ejects semen during ejaculation
6. **testis**- male reproductive organ in which spermatozoa (sperm) are produced
7. **vas deferens**- duct through which sperm travels from the testis to the urethra
8. **seminal vesicle**- gland which secretes components of semen into the vas deferens
9. **prostate gland**- gland that releases prostatic fluid into the urethra
10. **spermatozoa (sperm)**- mature male reproductive cells produced within the seminiferous tubules of the testis
