Male Urogenital System:

organs of the urinary system and reproductive system

- **1. kidneys** pair of organs in the abdominal cavity which remove waste from the blood and excrete it as urine
- **2. ureters** pair of ducts which transport urine from the kidneys to the bladder
- **3. bladder** muscular sac in which urine is collected for excretion
- **4. urethra-** duct through which urine and sperm are conveyed out of the body
- **5. penis-** male genital organ which eliminates urine from the body and ejects semen during ejaculation
- **6. testis-** male reproductive organ in which spermatozoa (sperm) are produced
- **7. vas deferens-** *duct through which sperm travels from the testis to the urethra*
- **8. seminal vesicle** gland which secretes components of semen into the vas deferens
- **9. prostate gland-** *gland that releases prostatic fluid into the urethra*
- **10. spermatozoa (sperm)-** mature male reproductive cells produced within the seminiferous tubules of the testis
