Interjection Injection Game

Interjection: Interjections are single words that show strong emotion and which can stand alone in a sentence. (Examples include Wow! Super! Bam!)

1) In the left-hand column list at least eight interjections. In the right-hand column, write a sentence. But here's the catch: You must write two of each kind of sentence by the time you are done.

Interjection List	Sentences: two declarative, two interrogative, two imperative, two exclamatory)

- 2) Now, cut out the interjections and sentences above. Put the interjections in a container labeled "Interjection Injection" and the sentences in a container labeled "Sentences."
- 3) Divide the class into two teams. Have someone from Team A select a sentence from the container. They earn one point if they can name the kind of sentence.
- 4) Now have the student pull an interjection from the other container. They earn another point if they can use that interjection with the sentence they initially drew and announce it to the class with the appropriate tone. You really need to sell it!

Example:

Sentence: I have to write a research paper.

Interjection: Fantastic!!

New Sentence: Fantastic, I have to write a research paper!!

5) Keep track of each team's score, just for fun.
