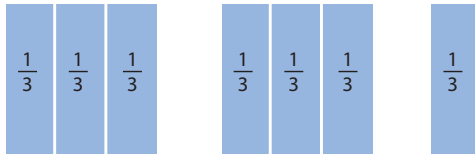


# Color the Improper Fraction

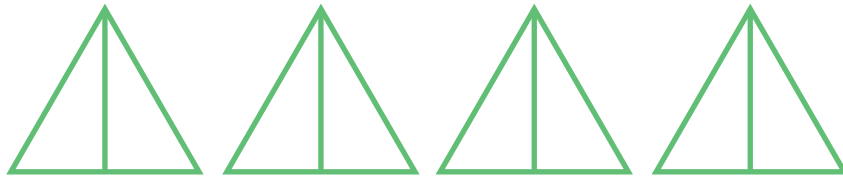
Color the correct improper fraction. See the example below.

When a fraction has a top number that is greater than or equal to the bottom number it is called an improper fraction.

**Example:**  $\frac{7}{3}$  means there are 7 parts. Each part is  $\frac{1}{3}$  of a whole.



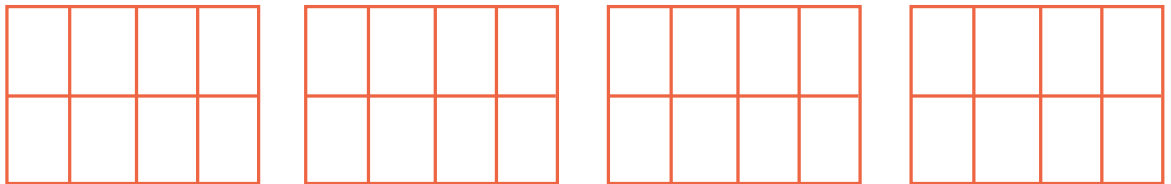
$$\frac{7}{2}$$
