| Nouns ending in: | Make Plural by: | Example |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| ch, sh, ss, x, zz | add -es | lunch $\longrightarrow$ lunches |
| a consonant and y | drop the y , add -ies | baby $\longrightarrow$ babies |
| f or fe | drop the f, add -ves | elf $\longrightarrow$ elves |
