

## It's Grammar Time: Plural Nouns Scoot

Scoot is a fun and engaging game for students to play as they practice different skills. They will enjoy getting to move around the classroom as they review important academic concepts.
*Before playing Scoot, instruct your students about how to move around the classroom. Be sure to practice so they are used to the structure of the game.

Teacher Directions:

1. Cut up the Scoot game cards and place them on each desk in the classroom.
2. Students will start with the card that is on their desk. They will record answers in the corresponding box on the answer sheet by looking at the number on the Scoot card.
3. Set a timer for a specific amount of time, such as 30 seconds, that the students have with each card.
4. When the timer goes off, signal to the students that they should rotate to the next card in numerical order. For example, if a student started at card \#8, they would move to card \#9.
5. As you play the game, students will record their answers on the Answer Sheet.
6. When a student has reached card \#24, they will rotate to card \#1.
7. Continue until students have visited each card. The game ends when students return to their own desks.

-Most singular nouns are made plural by adding -s.
-There are some other rules to follow depending on what letter the noun ends in:

| Nouns ending in: | Make Plural by: | Example |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| ch, sh, ss, $\mathrm{x}, \mathrm{zz}$ | add -es | lunch $\rightarrow$ lunches |
| a consonant and y | drop the y , add -ies | baby $\rightarrow$ babies |
| f or fe | drop the f , add -ves | elf $\longrightarrow$ elves |

-Irregular plural nouns do not follow any rules. You must memorize them!
Example: man $\longrightarrow$ men mouse $\longrightarrow$ mice tooth $\longrightarrow$ teeth
