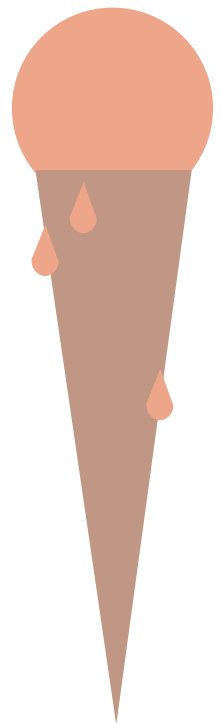


The Job of an Adverb
