

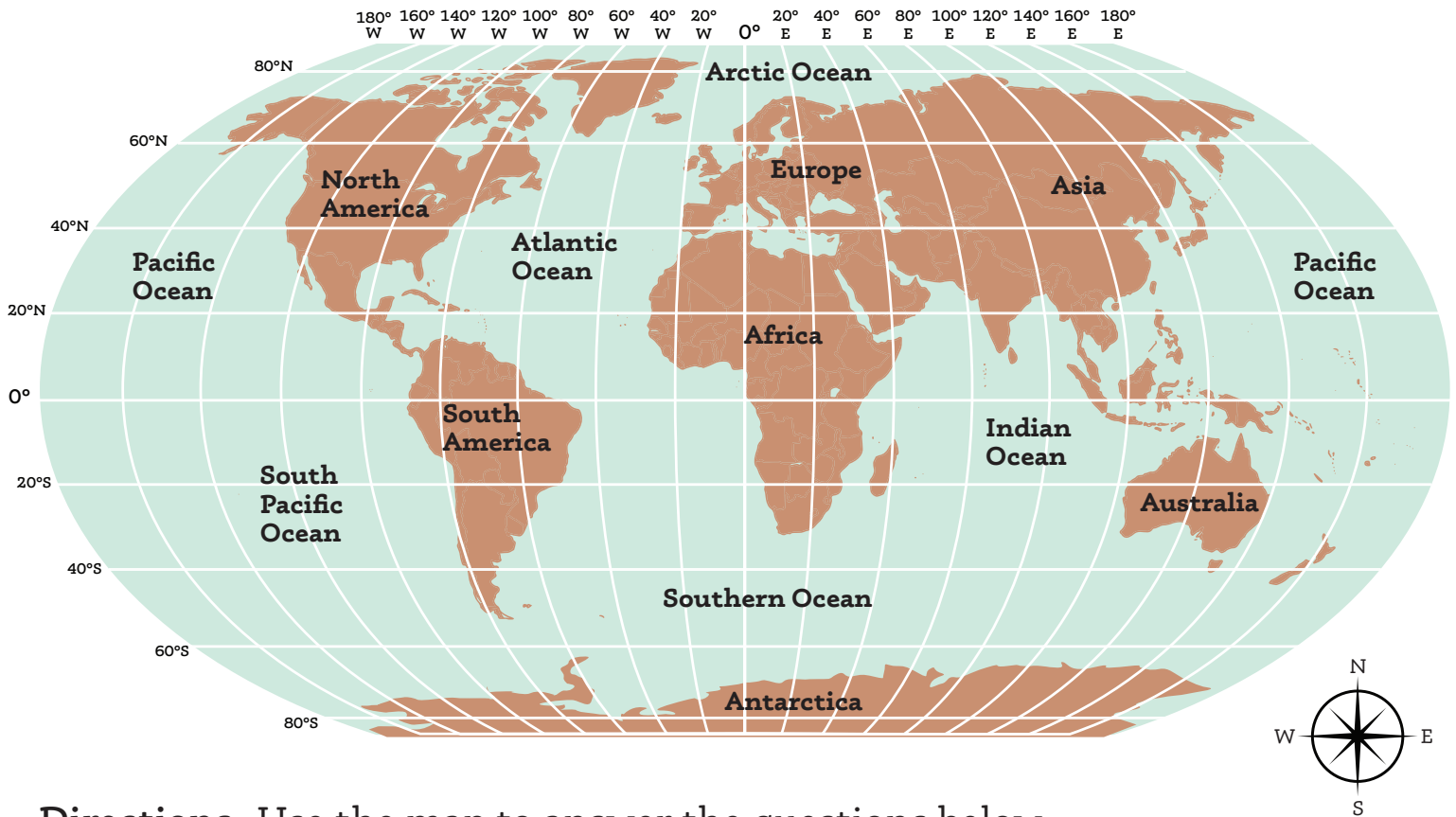

Latitude and Longitude

What are latitude and longitude, and how do you use them?

Latitude: lines that run in an east to west direction across the Earth.
(Latitude degrees are measured as north and south.)

Longitude: lines that run in a north to south direction across the Earth.
(Longitude degrees are measured as east and west.)
