In Morse codes, prosigns or procedural signals are not actual words, but they do have a meaning written in "code". For example, you may see on cartoons or movies "S.O.S." and wonder why they use that when they are on a stranded island. Well, it's a code that stands for "Save Our Souls" and the code is written as •••••••• and the sign is written \overline{SOS} .
