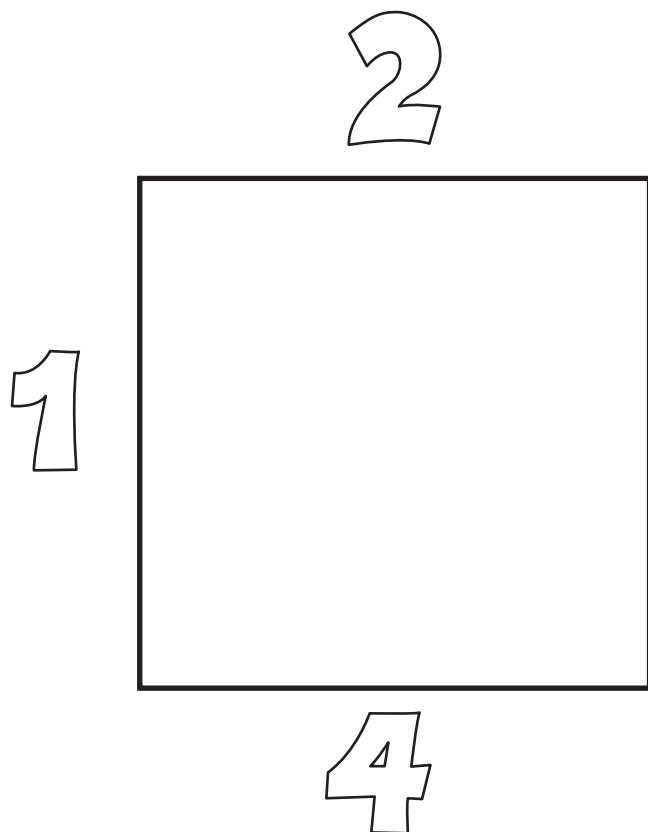
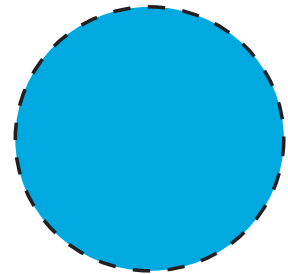
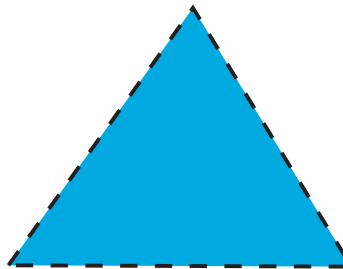


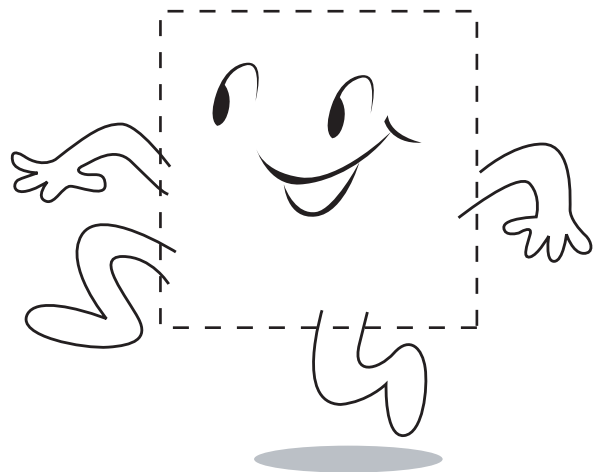
Learn the Shapes

To build the book of shapes ask your child to cut out the pages and help them fasten them together on one side. You can start with just the basic shapes, then add other pages later on.

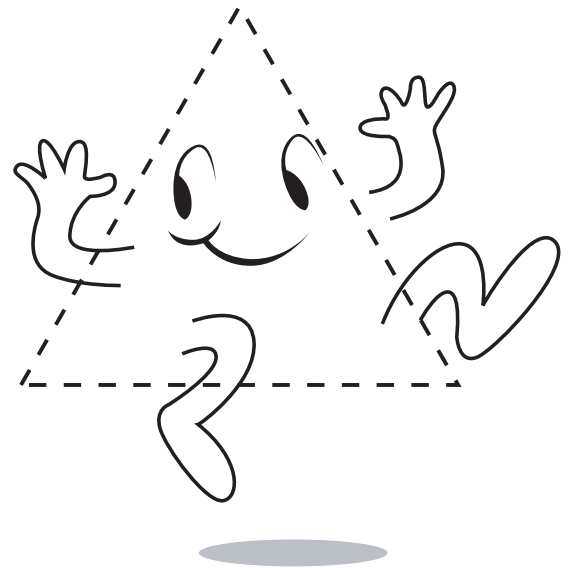
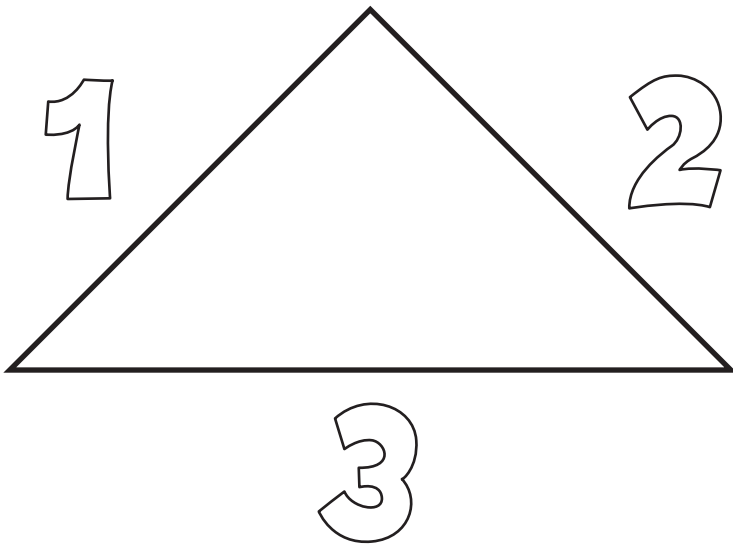
Then they can color each shape and trace its outline to learn more about it!



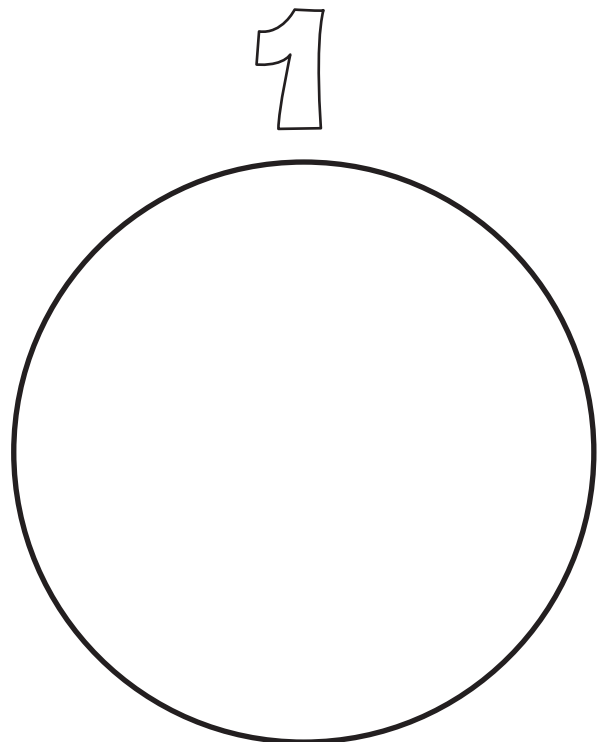
A square has four sides.

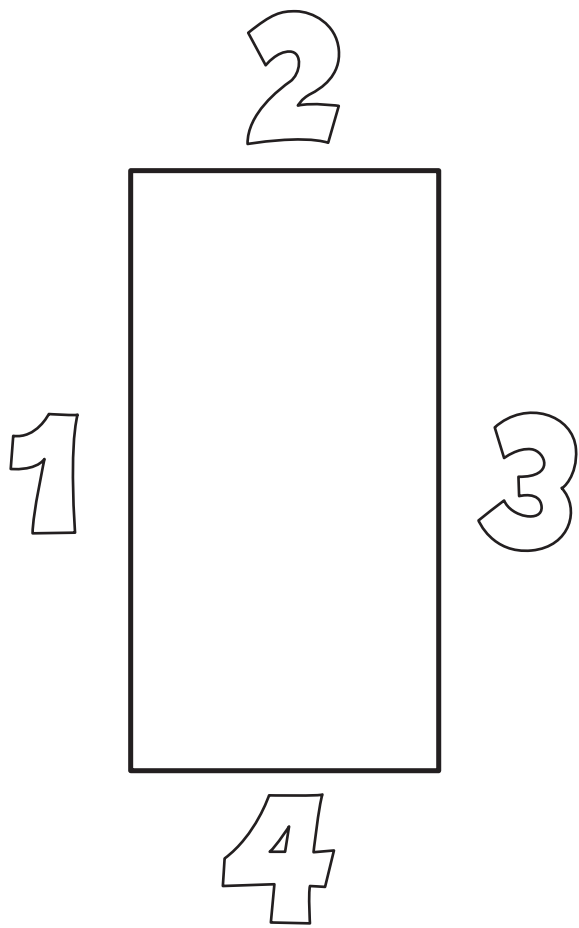


A triangle has three sides.

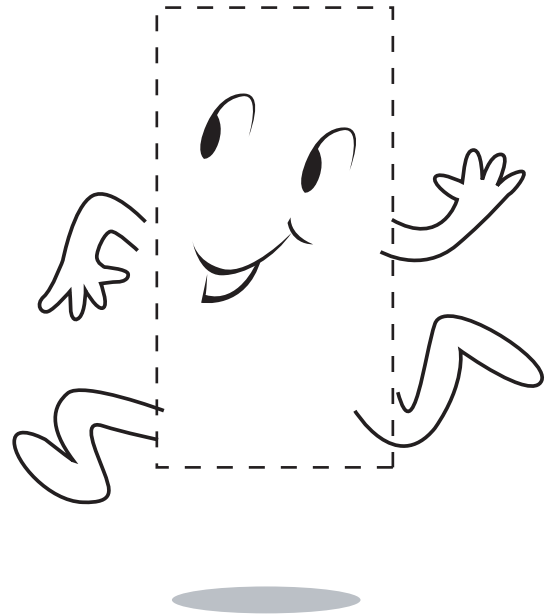

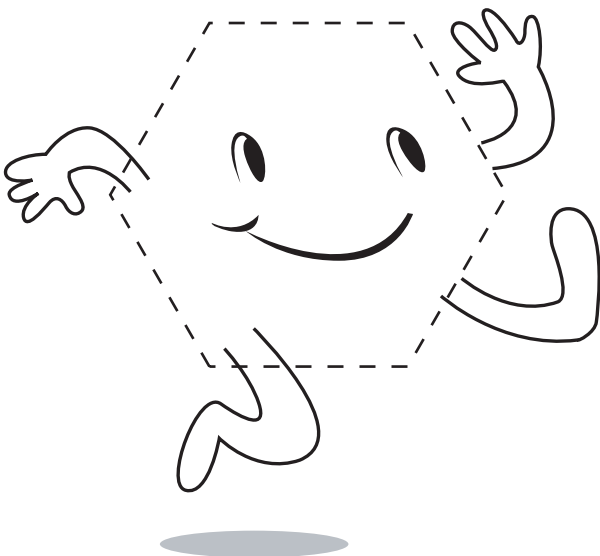
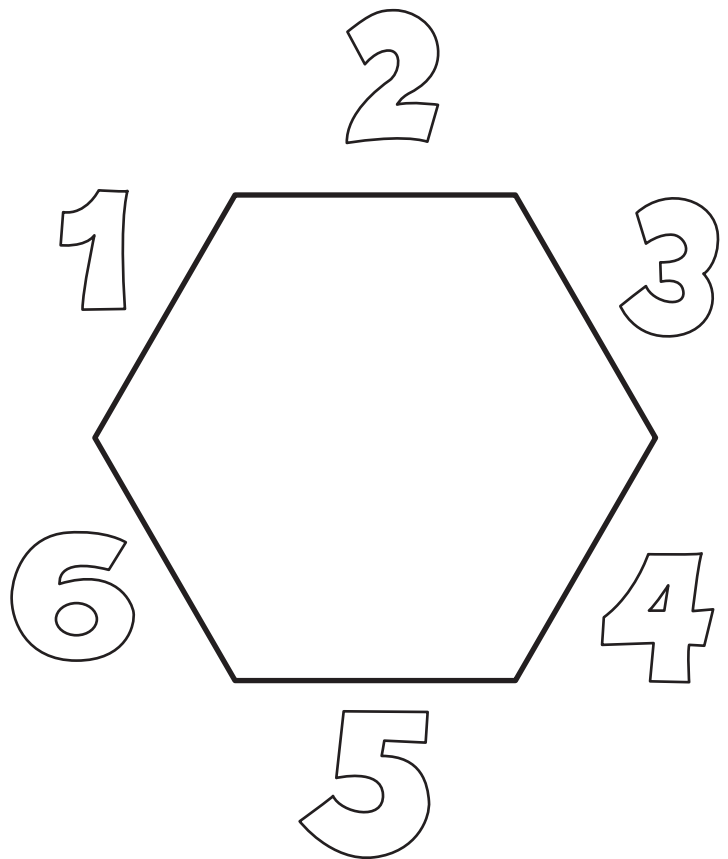
A pentagon has five sides.



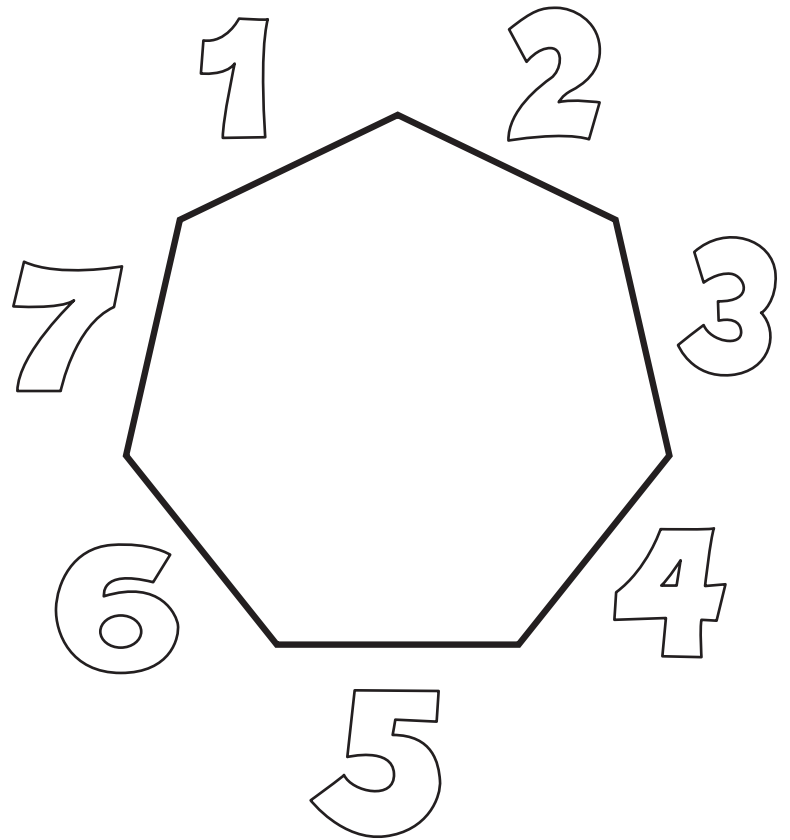
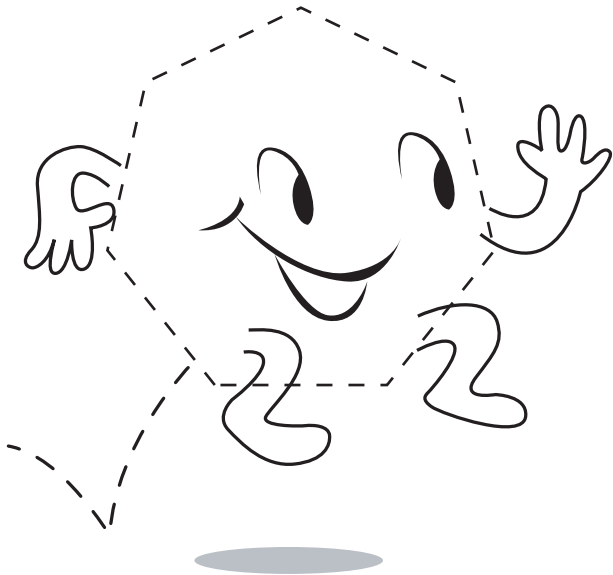
A trapezoid has four sides.
