- Alternate Author perspectives can be inferred by contrary or missing information from a text. Critical thinking requires readers to recognize author's perspective, then consider different or missing points of view on the topic. Considering alternate, even opposing perspectives, provides a more complete picture of a topic.
- Consider the following example:

Basketball is the most athletic of all team sports that requires specific talent in order to be successful. It is a team sport that was invented in the late 1800s. A basketball team is made up of athletes who play skilled positions. Each position requires certain skills and qualities. The five positions on a basketball team are the point guard, shooting guard, power forward, center, and small forward. Typically, the point guard is the leader of the team when on the court. This player must have strong ball-handling skills during the game. A leader on the court must be able to facilitate plays and get the team in position to score points.
