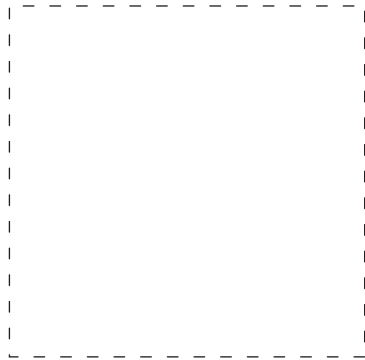

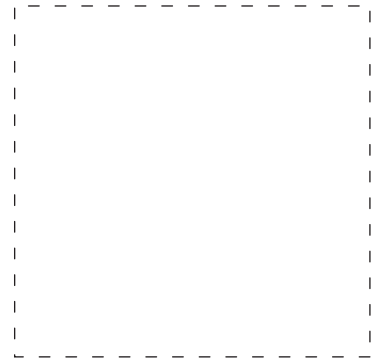
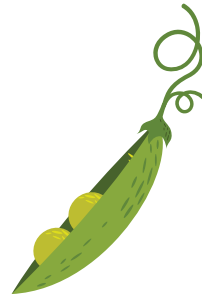
Oh no! Someone misunderstood these underlined idioms and took them literally. Write what they mean figuratively and draw a picture to illustrate each meaning.

1. It's his birthday today, so he's on top of the world!



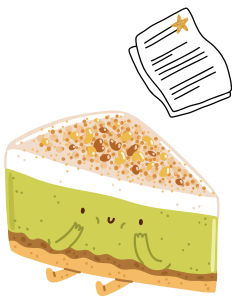

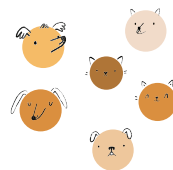
