**Cents** is the unit we use to make up a whole dollar.

**100 cents** equals a dollar.

**Cents are written** as a fraction of a dollar in decimals.

\$1.00 = **one whole dollar** = 100¢

The decimal point is placed after the whole dollar amount and before the cents.
