

MONEY WORD PROBLEMS #2



Solve the following money word problems.

Jeff has three five dollar bills, seven one dollar bills, six quarters, three dimes, a nickel and five pennies in his wallet.

How much money does Jeff have in all?

Tammy has a ten dollar bill, two five dollar bills, ten one dollar bills, a quarter, five nickels and three pennies in her purse.

How much money does Tammy have in all?

John has \$20.15 in his wallet. His friend Gene gives him four five dollar bills, four quarters, eight dimes and twelve nickels.

How much money does John have now?

Janine has \$16.80 in her purse. She spends a ten dollar bill, two one dollar bills, four dimes and ten pennies.

How much money does Janine have left?

Paul has two ten dollar bills, three five dollar bills, six dimes, five nickels and eleven pennies in his wallet. Mark has \$36.00.

Which boy has MORE money?

Alisha has four five dollar bills, eight one dollar bills, seven quarters, three dimes, two nickels and a penny. Joan has \$32.25.

Which girl has LESS money?
