

MONEY WORD PROBLEMS #3



Solve the following money word problems.

Daniel has two ten dollar bills, a five dollar bill, three one dollar bills, a quarter, five dimes and a nickel in his wallet.

How much money does Daniel have in all?

Margaret has six five dollar bills, four one dollar bills, six quarters, eight dimes and ten pennies in her purse.

How much money does Margaret have in all?

Eddie has \$24.20 in his wallet. His friend Frank gives him a five dollar bill, nine quarters, two dimes, a nickel and two pennies.

How much money does Eddie have now?

Tina has \$8.45 in her purse. She spends three one dollar bills, three quarters and ten dimes.

How much money does Tina have left?

Jason has four ten dollar bills, two five dollar bills, a one dollar bill, a quarter and five dimes in his wallet. Ted has \$51.35.

Which boy has MORE money?

Anne has three five dollar bills, nine one dollar bills, seven dimes, a nickel and five pennies. Barbara has \$25.00.

Which girl has LESS money?
