

Instructions:

Have an adult print out the cards onto card stock or regular paper. Cut out each card on the dotted lines.

How to Play:

Go Fish is a card game for 2-4 people. The cards are shuffled and placed in a pile in front of the players. This is called a "stack".

Each player is dealt 5 cards. Starting with the youngest person, each player asks another (example): "Do you have any pink monsters?" You cannot ask for a card that you are not holding.

Continue to ask until the players do not have the cards asked for. Then the player would say "Go Fish" and take one card from the stack.

When you collect 4 of the same cards, place them in front of you. This is called a "book" of cards.

Continue to play until the stack of cards in the middle is gone. The player with the most books wins!
