**Homophone:** Two or more words that have the same pronunciation but different meanings or spellings.

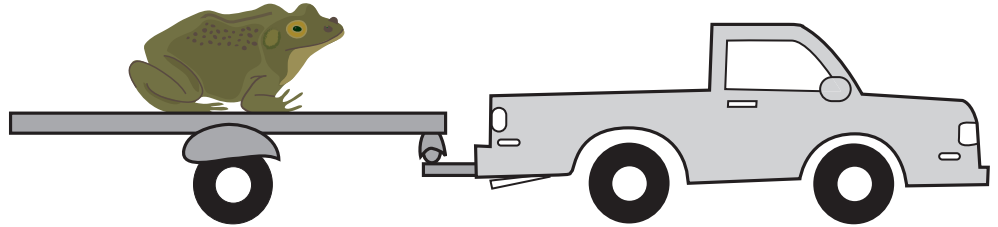
**Homonym:** Two or more words that have the same spelling and different meanings.
