

# Multiplication Cards for Number Talks

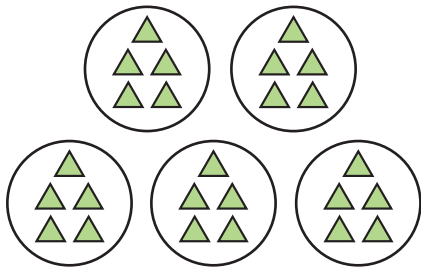
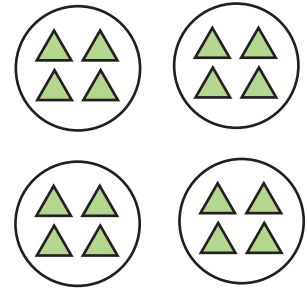
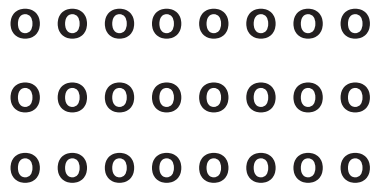


Cut up the cards and use them to spark conversations about multiplication facts. Show each card briefly to students, and ask them the following guiding questions.
