

NON-IDENTIFYING CLAUSES

Add a non-identifying clause to each sentence below. Remember to add a comma before and after the clause. Look at the example below for more help.

EXAMPLE

The grocery store sells organic fruit.

The grocery store , **which opened last week** , sells organic fruit.

My sister has the summer off.

My sister , **who is a teacher** , has the summer off.
