

North American Animal Tracks

While walking through the woods you may not see any wild animals, but you might see signs that they've been there. Check the soft ground like sand, mud or snow, for animal tracks. Mammals of the dog and cat family walk on four toes. Bears, raccoons, and rodents walk on five toes. Some animals have padded paws, some have claws to dig through dirt, and others have hooves. The animals pictured below are all **North American Mammals**.

Can you guess which animal left which tracks? Draw a line from the animal to its tracks.



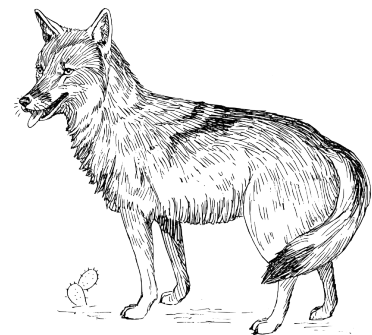
a. Mole
