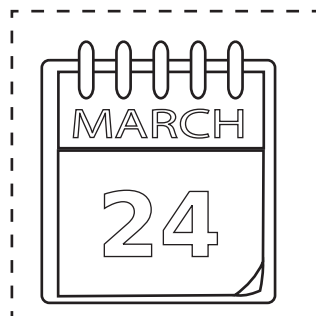
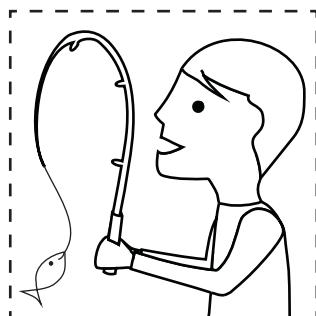
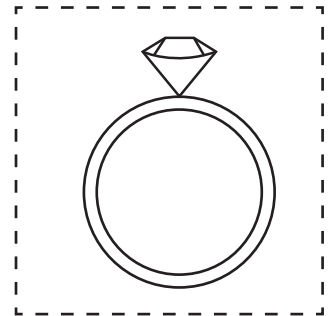
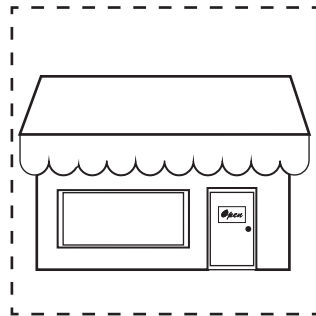
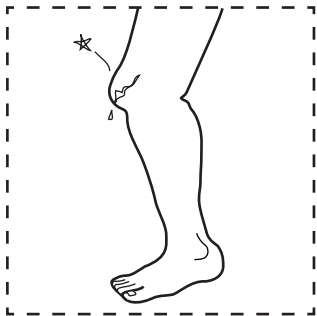
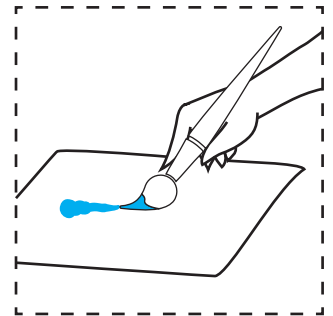
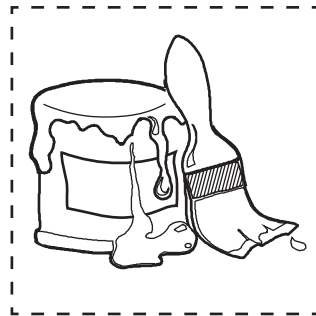
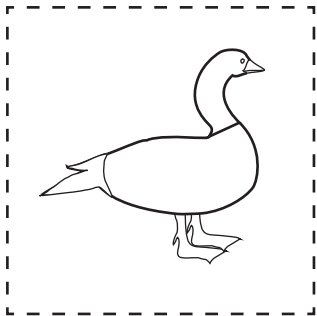
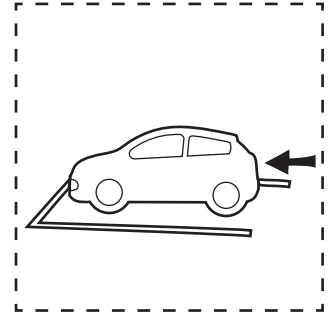
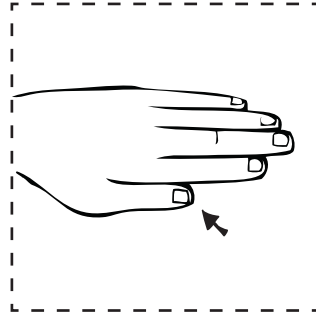
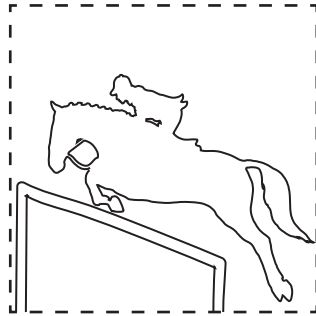
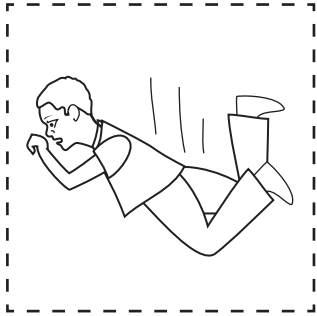
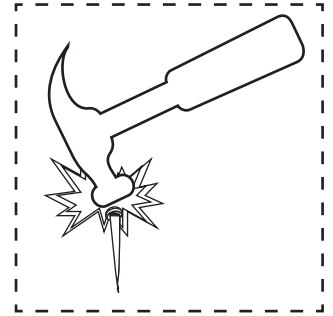
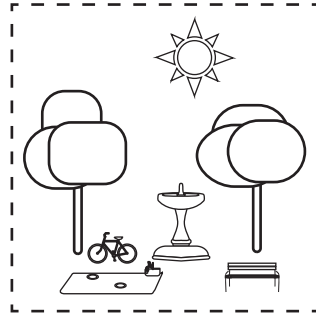
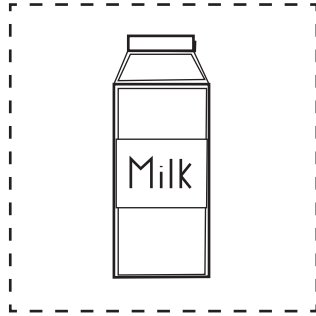
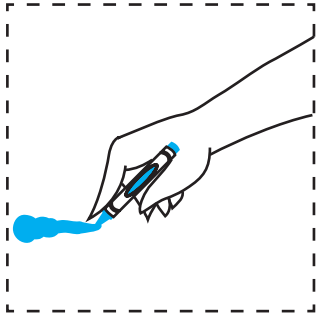
Noun-Verb Match-Up
