Nouns and Associated Pronouns

A **subject** is who or what the sentence is about. The subject is usually a noun.

A **noun** is a word that names a person, place, or thing. A pronoun is a word that takes the place of a noun or noun phrase.

Example: My brother ran on the sidewalk. He carefully stayed out of the street.
