1. Jim Crow laws

Prejudice and racism were legally protected by the government during the 1930s. Jim Crow laws were a set of unfair laws that denied equal treatment to African American people between the end of the Civil War and the 1960s. The laws segregated, or separated, people according to race, impacting public places such as schools, transportation, and restaurants. Consequences for standing up to or openly defying the laws included arrest, fines, jail time—even beatings or death.

2. Sharecropping


Sharecropping is a system of farming in which a farmer rents a small piece of land from a landowner in exchange for a share of the crop. Sharecropping benefits landowners and often leaves the farmer indebted to the landowner. Many formerly enslaved people became sharecroppers after slavery was outlawed.

3. The Great Depression

The Great Depression was a time of great economic crisis during the 1930s. While it began with a stock market crash in the United States, the depression spread worldwide. Many people were out of work and unable to meet their basic needs, such as food and shelter. In addition to the harsh economic conditions in the 1930s, the Great Plains in the United States faced harsh environmental conditions—the worst drought in U.S. history. Things became even worse for farmers when high winds stirred up the dry soil, causing huge dust storms. The affected area became known as the Dust Bowl.
