Think about the major characters in the story—such as Katniss, Peeta, Gale, and Rue—as well as minor characters—such as Katniss's mother, Madge, Foxface, and Caesar Flickerman.

Choose six characters from the novel who each represent one of the character archetypes listed below.


The Ally	The Bully	The Caregiver	The Creator	The Guardian

*Remember, character archetypes are based on patterns of behavior and driving motivations, not just one-time events!

On the left side of each card, draw a picture of the character. Write their name at the top and where they're from in the circle at the bottom.


In the gold bars on either side of the card, write the archetype that the character represents.

On the right side of each card, write the character's name at the top, and complete the labeled sections. Use evidence from the novel to help you.




Once you've completed each card, cut around the outer edge, and then fold the card in half along the dotted line. Tape or glue the back sides together.
