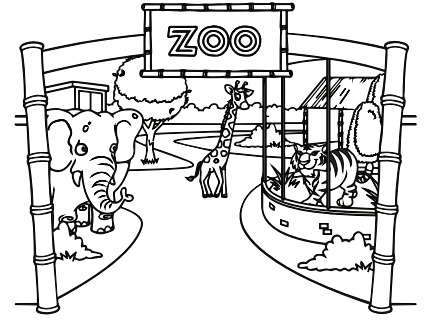




THE ONE AND ONLY IVAN: DESIGN A ZOO



Imagine you’ve been selected by your city to create a zoo. Your zoo will take in animals from a recently shut-down circus and bring in animals from other well-known zoos around the country. Use what you know about Ivan’s story and the guidelines below to plan a zoo that will provide a safe sanctuary for animals who have been captured, mistreated, or injured.

For this project, you’ll design the zoo’s layout, describe the animals that will live in the zoo, plan learning programs for zoo visitors, and create a brochure that advertises your zoo. You will create two products that present your planning—a multimedia project or poster and a brochure.

Product 1

Create a multimedia project or poster with a plan for your zoo.

- ◆ Include a layout for your zoo. Consider where you’ll put the habitats, walking paths, and other features, like a picnic area and restrooms.
- ◆ List the 10–15 types of animals that will live in your zoo. For each animal, write 3–5 sentences to explain how you’ll create a safe, happy life for them at your zoo.
- ◆ Plan 2 learning programs that your zoo will lead. Include information about why these programs are important and what visitors will learn and do as they participate.

Product 2

Design a brochure to encourage people to visit your zoo. Look at the template below to see what information you should include in each section. Be sure to include pictures and make your brochure colorful.
