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Order Topics From Broadest to Narrowest

A **topic** is the subject or focus of a piece of writing. The **scope** of a topic is the range of information the topic covers. A topic with a **broader** scope is more general and covers a wide variety of information. A topic with a **narrower** scope is more specific and covers a more limited range of ideas. Consider these topics:

- types of pollution
- air pollution
- impacts of wildfires on air pollution

Types of pollution has the broadest scope. It's the most general.

Air pollution has a narrower scope. It focuses on one type of pollution.

Impacts of wildfires on air pollution has the narrowest scope. Wildfires are a specific cause of air pollution.
