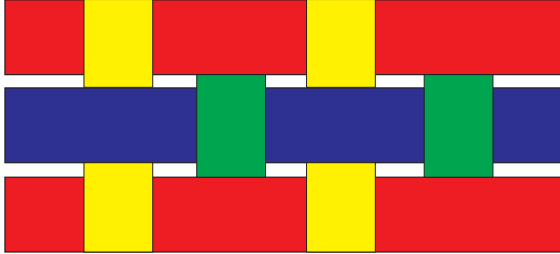
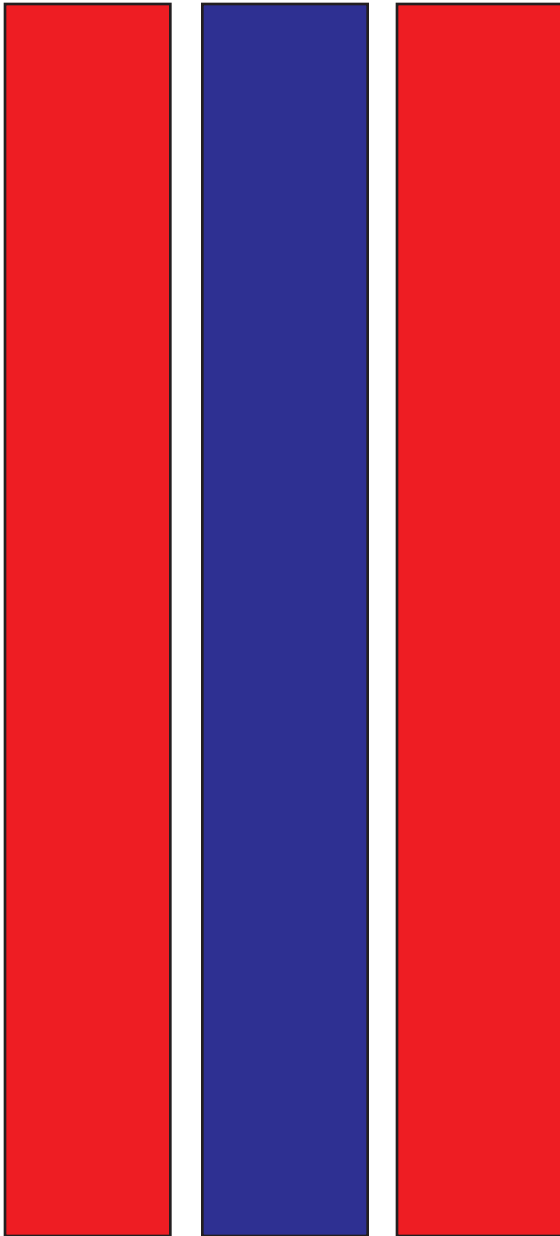


Weaving Project

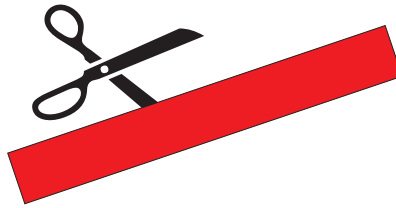


Finished sample

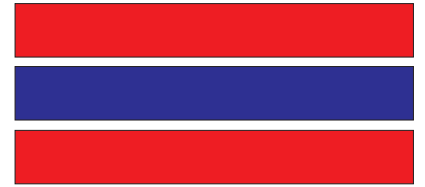


Directions Note: This worksheet is best if printed out in color.

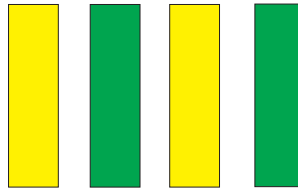
1. Cut out strips of paper.



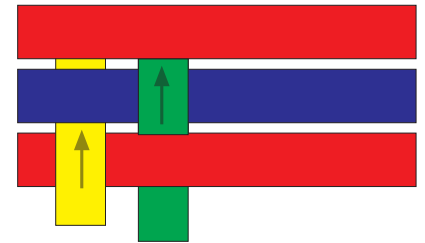
2. Place long strips horizontally.



3. Place short strips vertically.



4. Alternately weave short strips in an under/over fashion.



5. Using white glue or a glue stick, glue pieces together where they intersect. You can also glue everything down onto a piece of paper.
