

The True Story of Paul Revere

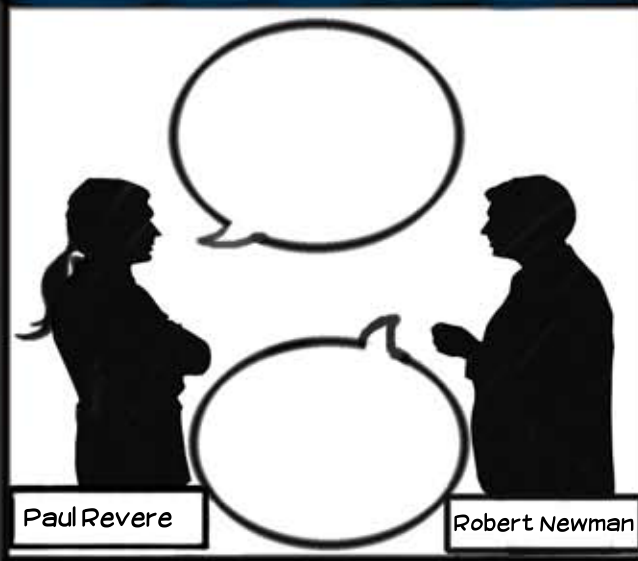

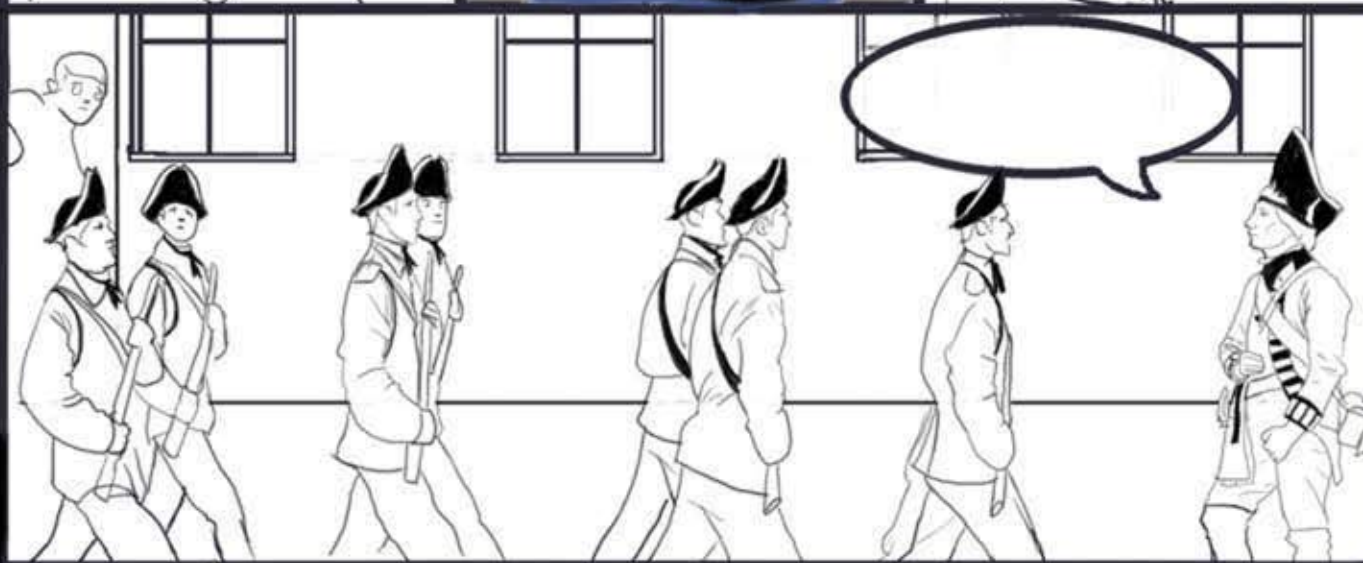

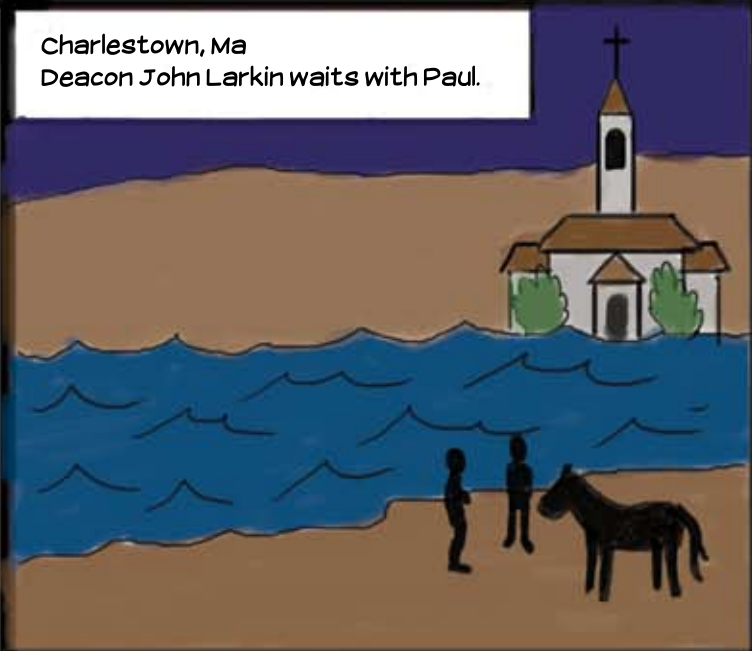

Paul look! I can see a light from the church!

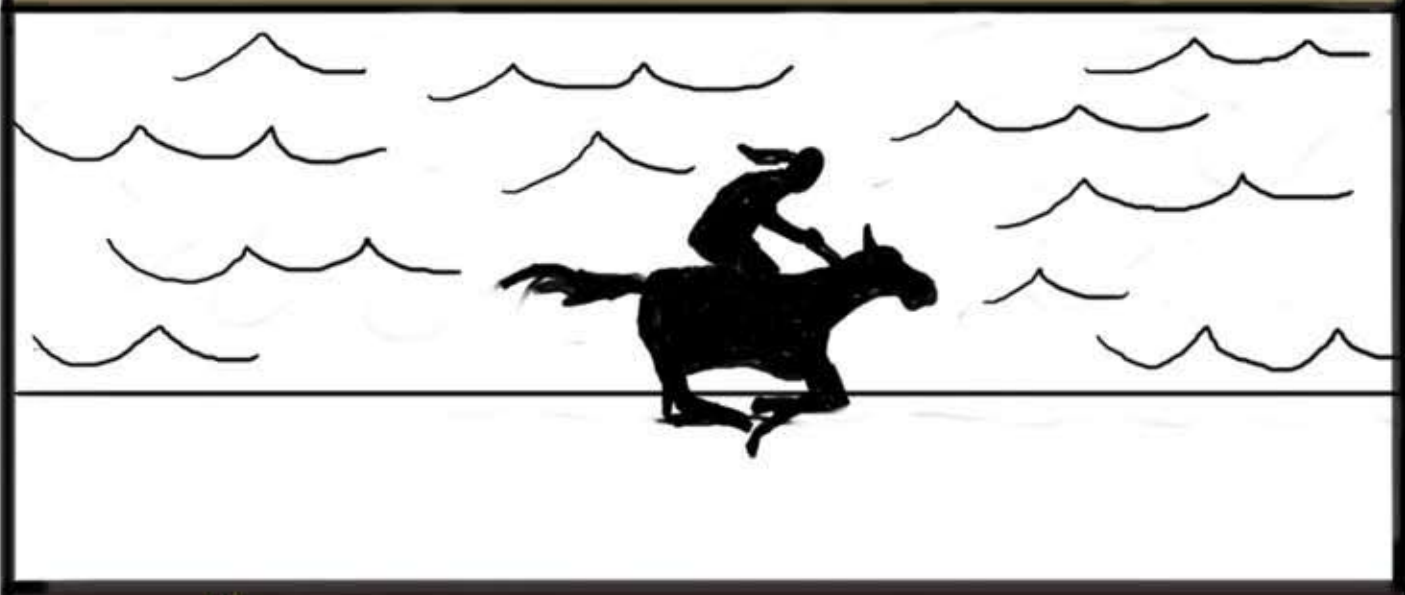

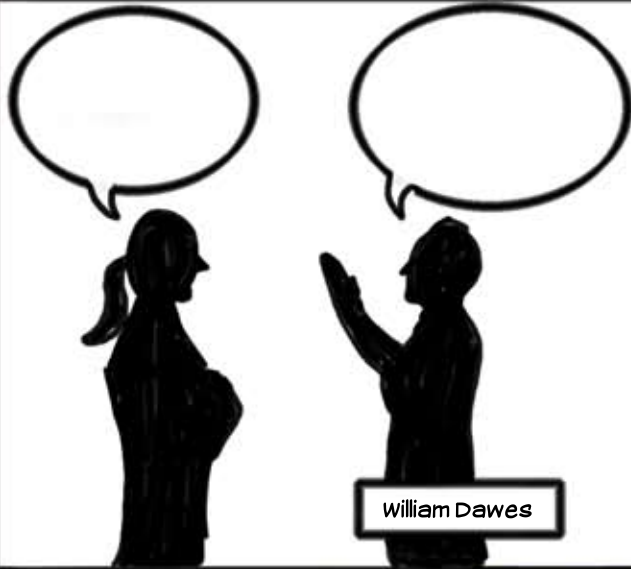
Paul heads to Medford to warn the town of the British soldiers.

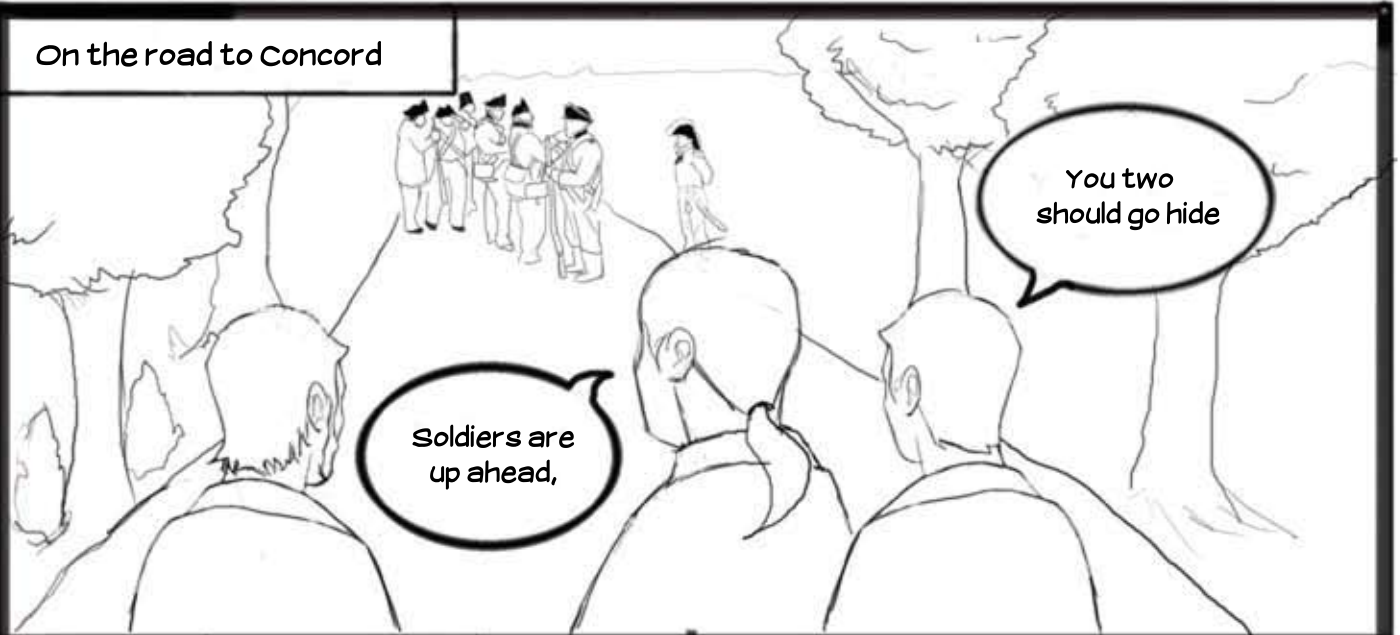
