# PEEL WRITING STRATEGY

The **PEEL strategy** is a helpful way to organize and structure your paragraph writing. You can use this strategy to write informational and argumentative paragraphs.

The PEEL acronym stands for **Point**, **Evidence**, **Explain**, and **Link**.

## POINT

Make a clear and relevant point that relates to the topic.

The writer explores...
The author implies...
It can be argued that...

E

# **EVIDENCE** or **EXAMPLES**

Use evidence or examples from the text to support your point.

For example... According to... For instance...

## **EXPLAIN**

Use at least two sentences to explain how your evidence supports your point.

The data reveals... The quote suggests... The image shows...

L

# LINK

Link back to your main point **or** transition to your next point.

It is clear that... In summary... Therefore...

Note: Sometimes, it makes sense to switch Evidence and Explain.
