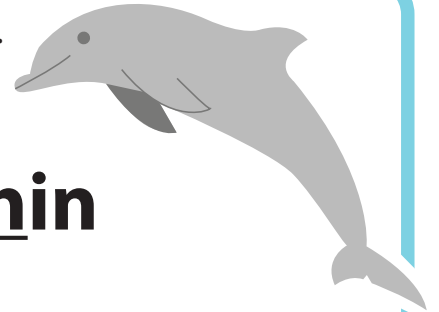


# Phonics Review: Digraphs: ph







A **digraph** is a combination of two letters that make one sound.
