
Adult sea turtles can grow to 5 feet (1.5 m) long and average between 240-420 pounds (110-190 kg).



Sea turtles can live up to 80 years.




Young green sea turtles are carnivores. This means they eat other animals and plants. They like jellyfish, sponges and other invertibrates.




As a sea turtle gets older, they are mostly herbivores. This means they only eat plants. They usually live in shallow waters and feed on seagrasses or marine algae.








A female sea turtle will return to the beach that she was hatched at in order to lay her eggs.




When the baby sea turtles hatch, they weigh about 1 ounce and are only about 5 cm (almost 2 in) long!
