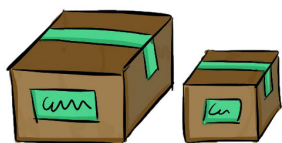
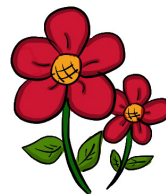


MORE THAN ONE

DIRECTIONS: Look at each picture below. Then add either an **s** or **es** to the end of each word to make the singular noun plural. Here is an example:

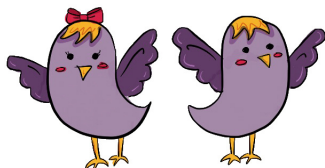
