Practice finding the area of each rectangle. First round the length and width. Then calculate the area using the formula. See how fast you can finish! Remember: Rectangular Area = length x width.

## Rounding to the nearest hundred

If the number in the tens place is 5 or greater, the hundreds digit goes up one. If the number in the tens place is 4 or less, the hundreds digit does not change. Example: $468 \rightarrow 500$ $712 \Rightarrow 700$
