

# Learning about Question Marks

With Franco and Julia



We ask *questions* when we want to find things out. Some words that ask *questions* are:

**Who What Where Why When How**

When we write a *question*, we use a *question mark* at the end of the sentence. Here is an example:

**What** did Franco have for lunch today?
