

To remind yourself of the power of music, you will create your own radio box craft! Ask your parents to describe what their radio or boom box looked like when they were growing up, and have them show you images!

Materials: Paper box, glue, white paper, cardboard, scissors, paints or markers, paper straw

Directions:

- 1. Glue all the sides of the box together.
- 2. Glue white paper on each side to cover the entire box.
- 3. Draw a radio face on the largest side of the box.
- 4. Using the cardboard and scissors, cut out four small squares, two small circles, two large circles, and one rectangle to fit in the center of your radio (like the image above).
- 5. Glue your shapes onto the front of your radio (like the image above).
- 6. Draw many lines across the large circles/speakers.
- 7. Use paint or markers to color your radio and buttons.
- 8. Glue the straw (when your paint has dried) at the top of your radio for the antenna.
- 9. You are rockin' it! You have completed your radio to be displayed on a shelf or in your room!
