



Ancient Egyptian Life Great Pharaoh Ramses ||

He had one of the longest reigns ruling for 66 years and died at about the age of 90 outliving his many wives and a few children. His greatness came from two things. The first was strategic campaigns he used to secure and expand the reach of Egypt. He headed many campaigns into the neighboring countries of Syria and Nubia. This brought much wealth and overall peace to the now unified area.

Ramses II also built on a grand scale, erecting temples and monuments. Pictured is Abu Simbel.
