Jonathan is building an outdoor staircase for his deck. He uses 8 screws for every 2 steps. If there are 14 steps, how many screws does Jonathan need?

Dominic makes some pizzas before opening his pizzeria each day. For every 3 cheese pizzas he makes, he makes 2 specialty pizzas. How many specialty pizzas will Dominic make if he makes 12 cheese pizzas?

In Alice's favorite video game, Coin Collector, she earns 12 points for every 5 coins she finds. In the first level, Alice found 35 coins. How many points did she earn in the first level?

The ratio of paintbrushes to bottles of paint in Ms. Nelson's supply closet is 8 to 3. If there are 48 paintbrushes, how many bottles of paint are there?

On Friday, the ratio of hamburger orders to hot dog orders in the school cafeteria was 15:10. If there were 50 hot dog orders, how many hamburger orders were there?

When Ruby works out, she spends 2 minutes stretching for every 15 minutes of exercise. Ruby spent 60 minutes exercising this morning. How long did she spend stretching?

Deja bought 6 bunches of mint for \$15 from the farmers' market last weekend. This weekend, she went back to buy 2 more bunches of mint. How much did Deja pay this weekend?

Valerie is making fruit salad using strawberries and melons. The ratio of strawberries to melons is 3:4. If Valerie makes 14 cups of fruit salad for a party, how many cups of strawberries does she use?

**10**

Noah is learning Portuguese, and he uses flash cards to study vocabulary. For every 5 new flash cards he practices, he reviews 10 old flash cards. Today, he practiced 45 flash cards in all. How many new flash cards did he practice?

**11**

When Terrance goes to the movie theater, he spends \$12 on a ticket and \$6 on snacks. Last month, Terrance spent a total of \$54 at the movie theater. How many times did Terrance visit the movie theater last month?
