Reading Comprehension Bookmark

When you don't know a word ...

1. Ask yourself:
 - "Does that make sense?"
 - "Does it sound right?"
 - "Does it look right?"
 - "What sound/letter does it start with?"
2. Look at the pictures.
3. Think of another word that might fit that makes sense.
4. Take a closer look at the word.
5. Does the word remind you of a word you know?
6. Does the word have a smaller word inside it that you know?
7. Read the word again.



Making Sense During (and After) Reading:

1. Ask yourself what is happening while you are reading the story. Try to put it in your own words.
2. Try to relate to things happening in the story.

Does this story remind you of other stories? • Has a situation in the story happened to you or someone you know? • If so, how does it impact you, your community, or the world?
3. How did the situation in the story come to be?

What would you do differently? • How are you like or unlike the main character? • How would you change the story's ending? • Is there a lesson to be learned? • What is the main idea of the chapter? • Why do you think the author wrote the story?
