

## ♻️ What is recyclable?

- ♻️ Aluminum and steel cans
- ♻️ Plastic beverage containers (e.g. water and soda bottles)
- ♻️ Clear glass bottles and jars
- ♻️ Plastic six-pack rings
- ♻️ Corrugated cardboard
- ♻️ Mixed paper - phone books, brochures; computer, notebook, white and colored office papers; envelopes, soft cover booklets, manila folders, card stock, glossy magazines, catalogs and newspaper

## ♻️ What is not recyclable?

- ♻️ pizza boxes and wax-coated cardboard - The grease and/or wax on these boxes interferes with the recycling process.
- ♻️ plastic bags - Recycle at your local grocery store.
- ♻️ plastic tubs - Some plastic tubs have the right number on the bottom, but they are not made the same way as plastic bottles. Because of their different chemical characteristics, including melting temperature, they cannot be recycled with bottles.
- ♻️ Styrofoam
- ♻️ Tops and lids of plastic and glass bottles and jars.
- ♻️ plastic utensils - These can be washed and reused.
- ♻️ plastic oil and pesticide containers
- ♻️ Ceramics, mirrors, window glass and drinking glasses.
