Habitat: rainforests, wet savannas, forested valleys, and near slow water in western and central Africa

Size: 2-3 feet high, 3-5 feet long, 100-270 pounds

Lifespan: 10-20 years

Eats: grasses, berries, roots, insects, small invertebrates, fruit, vegetables, hay, and sometimes dead animals

They are very social and live in groups of six to 20.

They are good swimmers, but can't hold their breath long underwater.
