New England (gray): Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island

Northwest (blue): Washington, Oregon

Northeast (violet): West Virginia, Maryland, Delaware, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York

Southeast (pink): Louisiana, Arkansas, Mississippi, Alabama, Georgia, Tennessee, Florida, Kentucky, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina

Southwest (orange): Arizona, New Mexico, Texas

West (yellow): California, Nevada, Utah, Idaho, Hawaii, Alaska
