

Subtrating Ones and Tens

$$\begin{array}{r} 59 \\ - 5 \\ \hline 4 \end{array}$$

First, subtract the ones.

Then subtract the tens.

$$\begin{array}{r} 59 \\ - 5 \\ \hline 54 \end{array}$$

Find the difference.
