Basic Part of Speech	Nouns	Verbs	Adjectives	Adverbs	Pronoun
<b>Job: What work does this kind of word do?</b>	Represents a person, place, thing, or idea	Shows action or state of being	Describes a noun or pronoun – usually the quality, size, or amount	Describes adjectives, verbs, or another adverb (often ends in -ly)	Replaces a noun
<b>Examples</b>	folder, sand, happiness	<b>Action:</b> jump, talk <b>State of being:</b> am, are, is	huge, two, hairy	gracefully, very, everywhere, hungrily	we, he, they
