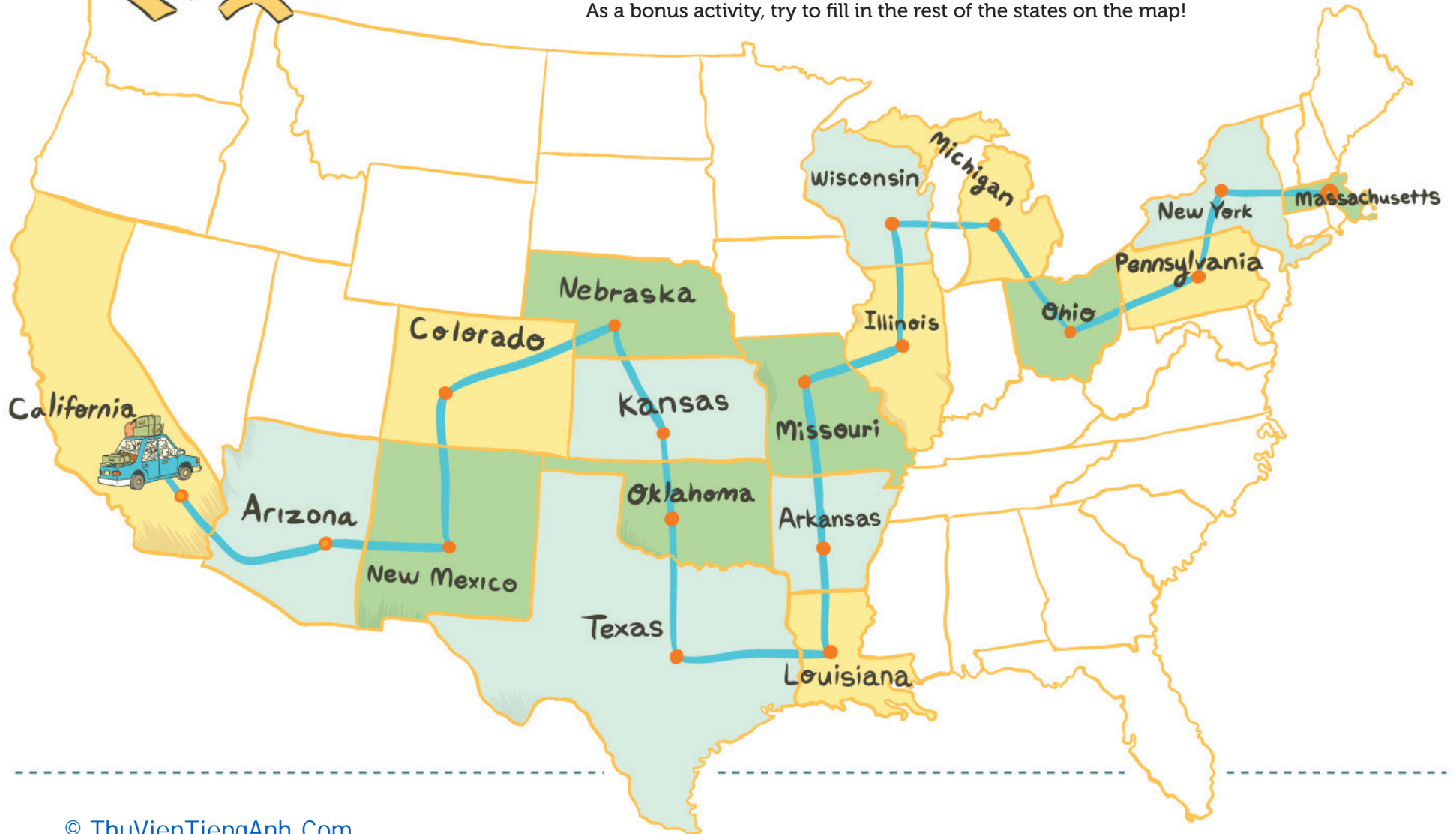


### American Bison

The American Bison is the state animal of The Sooner State.

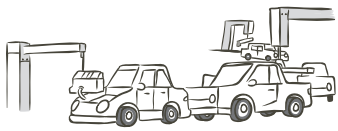

As a bonus activity, try to fill in the rest of the states on the map!



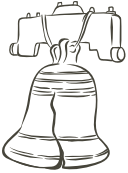
## Motor City

This amazing canyon is one of the 7 Natural Wonders of the World.



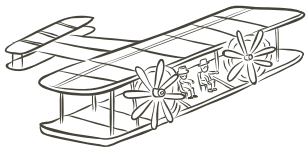
## Red Sox Baseball

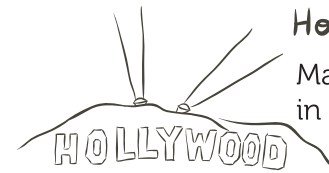
